Rooms are limited – please reserve early.

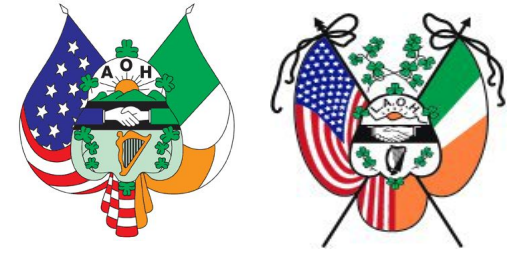

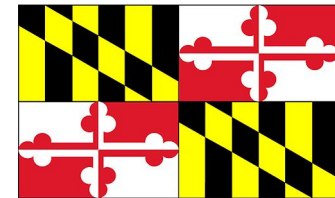

Solomons is a picturesque island town nestled in the joining of the Patuxent River and the Chesapeake Bay in Calvert County Maryland and an easy drive to historic St. Mary's City.

Discover nature's wonder and pan for ancient sharks teeth at nearby Calvert Cliffs State Park, enjoy a day on the water or a casual stroll or bike ride around the island. Stroll the Riverwalk.
