If you require a handicap room, notify the reservations agent when you call to reserve your room.

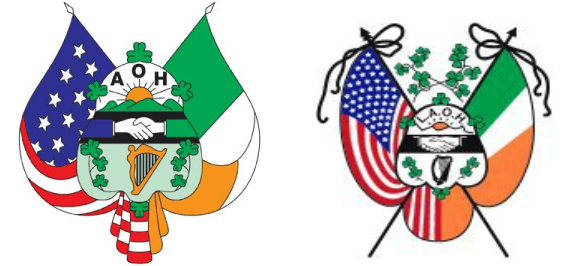
The Convention room rates are:

Saturday, October 30, 2021

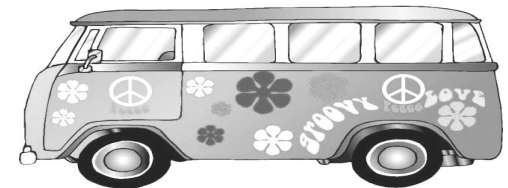
